Describing the Good News

Fourteen Aspects of the Gospel

People sometimes want the good news of the Christian gospel defined. I can't do that, but here is a description of some aspects of the Gospel and what it means for me, based on a range of Biblical passages.

- It is about **JESUS**: He calls me to follow Him, walk with Him, share His life and join in His mission of love and life.
- It is about a new LIFE: following Jesus means an end to the life I lived before I met Him.
- It is about a new **COMMUNITY**: I am now a child of God, a member of His family, a part of the Body of Christ.
- It is about ACCEPTANCE: Jesus calls me to follow Him as I am I don't need to get cleaned up and sorted out first.
- It is about **RELATIONSHIPS**: about other people, not about me, my destination or my status.
- It is about LOVE: love God, love your neighbour, love yourself; rejoice that God loves me unconditionally.
- It is about **FAITH**: believing that Jesus can be trusted, that He tells the truth and means what He says in commanding me to follow Him.
- It is about **TRANSFORMATION**: God's Spirit works within to change me as I follow Jesus.
- It is about TRUST: believing that God wants the best for me, and is able to achieve it.
- It is about **OBEDIENCE**: God does not force Himself on me, I have to respond to Him.
- It is about **RESURRECTION**: the only way to experience resurrection life is to be willing to die to my own plans and purposes.
- It is about God's **GRACE**: what He can do and what He offers to do for me, not what I deserve.
- It is about God's **POWER**: not about my ability, my faith or my goodness.
- It is about God's **KINGDOM**: about God's will being done in every area of life, not just the religious bits.

This is, I believe, all true, but the focus here is wrong – the Gospel is not about me, or about what God has done for me: it is about what He has done and continues to do for the whole world, for every person and for all creation.
